

#### STUDENT CONTRIBUTION REFUND POLICY

\*CSQ Funded Student Contribution refunds must be requested in writing within seven days from course enrolment and three days prior to course commencement. Withdrawal request must be made on the Withdrawal Request Form. This must be signed by the student and where applicable, referring 3<sup>rd</sup> party and submitted for approval to <a href="mailto:training@voltedge.com.au">training@voltedge.com.au</a>.

If approved, refunds will be processed via Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) seven days after the request has been received. If an offer of a place is withdrawn, or Volt Edge is unable to provide the program, the student is eligible for a full or pro rata refund of tuition fees paid within seven days.

## **CSQ FUNDING ACCESS**
