Course Description

The student normally an Electrician but non Electrical personnel can complete the High Voltage recipient course and receive a Statement of Attainment once deemed competent.

This person once familiarised with your site can be signed off to receive access and test permits in a High Voltage installation, manage the process and then surrender when finished the HV work, as part of a High Voltage switching procedure or program.

The training course has a practical component if using an access system to plan, complete and manage a HV permit system. This is completed on two occasions once using Volt Edge permit systems and one using your own permit systems.



Delivery

With 80:20 theory to practical, the theory and assessment practicals are completed and submitted online at the students pace.



Unit of Competency

UEPOPS021 - Control permit to work operations.



Entry Requirements

Students will need to be working and have a supervisor/mentor who holds the unit of competency to sign off on third party forms. If not employed or have access, students can book in to attend a training centre to complete practical requirement.



Assessments

Students will complete a theory assessment and workplace observation.
