



# Course Description:

High Voltage Coordination is designed for a HV Supervisor or some-one that has at least done some HV Supervision in the past, or wants to become a HV supervisor in the future. The course covers Coordination of crews of HV operators and studies the interaction that may occur between one or more HV crews.

This course delivers Nationally Recognised Outcomes for HV Coordination skill set on how to coordinate local HV networks, coordinate and direct switching programs, coordinate power system permit procedures & coordinate and direct power system switching schedules.

The practical plans an approximate 2 day switching program of 4 individual exercises and ensures that tasks are resourced, planned and coordinated using modern planning techniques, so that the separate exercises do not interfere or endanger the other members. The practical also uses Access and Test permits where appropriate and concentrates on the coordinators role in these exercises.

# Duration and Mode of Delivery:

As one of our most popular online courses, HV Coordination takes roughly 2 days online self-paced to complete. HV Coordination is available online self-paced only model for public students. Face to face training is available for onsite closed courses only.
